Training

Full time training, board and lessons included - \$950

- Horses that are in to be started under saddle and troubled horses are required to have a two (2) month minimum.

Part time training, board and lessons included - \$725

- This is an exercise program for already trained horses. Horses **must be pre-approved** by trainer to be put in this program. Three sessions a week.

Board (included with training price)

- Board includes twice daily feeding (up to 4 flakes/day), shavings, and daily manure clean up. Horses are fed a combination of grass and alfalfa hay, depending on what is available in the area at the time.
- Additional boarding options:
 - Grain Supplementation - recommended on an as needed basis (no charge when grain is pre-bagged, can for grain strongly recommended)
 - Blanketing – recommended on an as needed basis (no charge)
 - Turnout (no charge)
 - Additional shavings - recommended for “messy” horses or horses that prefer deep bedding \$50
 - Additional hay – recommended for hard keeping horses \$50/month

Lessons

Lessons are one hour in length. You will get in depth information and explanation on biomechanics, equitation, horse psychology, feel, timing and balance. Riders are recommended to be prepared with boots and riding pants. Bring a helmet if you would like or there are loaner helmets if you would like to borrow one. Helmets are required for riders under 18.

Lesson Policies

- Riders are expected to be ready for their lesson at the time they are supposed to ride. If your horse is not ready to ride, in general or is being fractious on any given day, they will be worked with what they require that day. If you know your horse will need prep work to pick up with the desired material for your lesson, it is your responsibility to warm them up, riding or on the ground before your lesson time.
- 24 hour cancellation notice required
- No show – full cost of lesson

Hauling

Minimum Charge \$50

Cost per mile \$1

- Cost per mile subject to change with price of fuel.

Day Fees

Horse purchase evaluation \$75

Travel time for evaluation - .50/mile

Show fee - \$50

Hauling for shows - .75/mile
