

# **2024 Price Sheet**

## **Training**

Full time training, lessons included - \$650/month
Part time training - \$400/month (pre-approved horses only)

#### **Board**

Stall Boarding - \$600/month

- Board includes twice daily feeding (up to 4 flakes/day) premium grass hay and alfalfa, shavings (2 bags a week), and daily manure clean up. Horses are fed a combination of grass and alfalfa hay, depending on what is available in the area at the time.
- Full training horses must be stalled.

Group Pasture Board - \$450/month (when available)

• Board includes twice daily feeding (up to 4 flakes/day) in a max group of 3.

#### Additional boarding options:

- Grain Supplementation recommended on an as needed basis (no charge for horses in training), grain should be pre-bagged with a storage container. Not available for pasture boarded horses. \$30/month
- Blanketing recommended on an as needed basis (included for training horses)
   \$30/month
- Turnout (included for training horses) 3 days/week \$30, 5 days/week \$50
- Additional shavings recommended for "messy" horses or horses that prefer deep bedding \$10/bag or current cost
- o Additional hay recommended for hard keeping horses \$50/month

#### Lessons

Private lesson (50 minutes) - \$60 Shared lesson (50 minutes) - \$50/rider Lunge line lesson (30 minutes) - \$40 Saturday group (1.5 hours) - \$50/rider Horse rental fee - \$10/lesson/horse



#### **Lesson Policies**

- Riders are expected to be ready for their lesson at the time they are supposed to ride. For capable riders, arrive at least 15 minutes early to prepare your horse.
- 24 hour cancellation notice required, otherwise lesson will be charged full price. Routine cancellations may be asked not to come back.
- Any prepaid packages are valid for the month they were purchased.
- Standing appointments take precedence over other lessons.

### Hauling

Minimum Charge - \$100 Cost per mile \$1.25

• Cost per mile subject to change with price of fuel.

Hauling for shows – \$50 minimum or 1.00/mile

### **Day Fees**

Horse purchase evaluation \$100 Travel time for evaluation - .75/mile Off site lessons (when available)

- Immediate Cool area \$75
- Off the divide \$100

#### **Endurance Rides**

Endurance ride coaching (at event) - \$300 Endurance horse rental/coaching (to local rides) \$500

## Horse Show Rates (per day)

Daily show rate for trainer \$100/day
School horse fee \$50/day
Travel Time (not trailering) \$25/hour
Grooming prior to Horse Show (including bath and some clipping) \$30/horse
Day Care (only stall cleaning, water/feed) \$25.00 per day

Trainer accommodations and meals to be divided equally among clients. Bedding, tack room, misc., will be divided equally among clients per horse.

Sale horses must be on site and in a training program and should be sale ready by time of marketing.

Monthly charges for training and other incidental services are due on the **First Day of Each Month**. **Training activities will be stopped if payment has not been made in full by the 10th** day of the month, **unless prior arrangements have been made with the TRAINER**. A billing fee of 5% of the total amount due will be added to any balances not paid after 30 days of the billing date, and will continue to be added to the total owed to TRAINER for **every 30 days** the balance remains unpaid.
